1	WRITTEN BY GOD'S OWN HAND
Bible Reference: Exodus 24:12, Exodus 34:1, Daniel 5:5	
Description: The Bible is a love letter from God, who put all the words in the Bible because He wants us to know and remember how much He loves us. God even wrote three times with His own hand.	
2	THE FORGOTTEN WORD
Bible Reference: 2 Chronicles 34:1-35:19	
Description: When Josiah became King at the age of eight, he knew his people were not serving God as they were supposed to. After the high priest Hilkiah discovered the books of God's law, Josiah knew what to do.	
3	THE DEAD CANNOT WITNESS
Bible Reference: Luke 16:19-31	
Description: A rich man asked for the poor beggar Lazarus to go back to life and warn his brothers of what had happened to him, but he found out that living people have the scriptures to tell them how they should to live.	
4	DO NOT BE LED ASTRAY
Bible Reference: Deuteronomy 7	
Description: The people of Israel learned that when they disobeyed God's commands and allowed others to lead them away from worshipping God, He allowed peace to leave their land and let their enemies come in.	
5	THE OBEDIENT SON
Bible Reference: Matthew 3:13-17 and Luke 3:21-22	
Description: John the Baptist recognized Jesus as God, did not think he should baptize Him. Jesus explained they must obey the plan of God the Father. John baptized Jesus the Obedient Son.	
6	MARY'S BABY
Bible Reference: Luke 1:26-38	
Description: Gabriel told Mary that she was not to be afraid because God favored her and He was going to give her a baby boy and she should name Him Jesus.	
7	NOT IN THE GRAVE
Bible Reference: Matthew 28:6-9 and John 20 and 21	
Description: Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus carried the dead body of Jesus to the tomb. Yet, when the women went to the tomb on the third day, the body of Jesus was not there, because He risen from the dead.	
8	DEATH IS NOW SLEEP
Bible Reference: Matt. 9:18, 23-26 / Mark 5:22-23, 35-43 and Luke 8:41-24, 49-56	
Description: The people knew the little girl was dead, but Jesus said to her, "Little girl, I say to you, get up!" She got up from her bed as if she had been only taking a nap.	
9	THE SOURCE OF SALVATION
Bible Reference: Acts 2:5-41	
Description: Jesus the Nazarene, who died on the cross, then rose to life again on the third day, and brought an end to death. Peter explained that to receive His salvation we need only to repent.
