10	<b>THE BREATH OF GOD</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Genesis 2:7	
<b>Description:</b> God created man and woman for holiness, because He said He created them in His own image, and He is Holy. Of all creation, man is the only part into which God breathed life.	
11	<b>WHEN SIN CAME IN</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Genesis 3	
<b>Description:</b> God created man for holiness, but Sin came into the world when man decided to listen to the voice of the devil and eat the fruit of the knowledge of good and evil instead of obeying God.	
12	<b>BORN INTO SIN</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Genesis 4	
<b>Description:</b> God told Cain that if he would do what is right, his anger would leave and he would be blessed. Cain decided not to listen to God...	
13	<b>THE BLOOD SACRIFICE</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Genesis 3:21 / Exodus 12:1-13 and John 19	
<b>Description:</b> God requires a sacrifice of blood in order for sin to be forgiven. Innocent animals were sacrificed for the sin of Adam and Eve. Once Jesus died on the cross, the ultimate and final blood sacrifice was made.	
14	<b>PETER'S DENIAL</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Matthew 26:69-75 / Mark 14:66-72 / Luke 22:54-62 and John 18:25-27	
<b>Description:</b> Peter began to swear and say he was not one of Jesus' followers. Just then, a rooster started to crow. Peter realized he had betrayed Jesus and he ran away and cried as if he would never stop.	
15	<b>THEY SAW NO GUILT IN PAUL</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Acts 24, 25 & 26 (especially Acts 26:32)	
<b>Description:</b> Felix said Paul had done nothing to deserve death. Festus did not see any guilt in Paul. Agrippa also could not find any guilt in Paul. Paul asked to be sent to Caesar.	
16	<b>THE ETHIOPIAN BAPTISM</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Acts 8:26-39	
<b>Description:</b> God showed Philip a chariot and told him to run and catch it. In the chariot was a man from Ethiopia. Philip told the Ethiopian the good news about Jesus. The Ethiopian asked if he could be baptized...	
17	<b>THE LORD'S SUPPER</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Matthew 26:26-30 / Mark 14:22-26 and Luke 22:14-20	
<b>Description:</b> Jesus and His disciples celebrated Pass-over together each year. At their last Pass-over together Jesus did some things that were unusual...	
18	<b>THE FIRST GENTILE BAPTISM</b>
<b>Bible Reference:</b> Acts 10:44-48	
<b>Description:</b> Peter did not understand that Jesus is also the Savior of the Gentiles, until he went to preach at Cornelius' house. When he saw them saved by Jesus, Peter baptized Cornelius and his family in water.
