19	WAIT FOR THE PROMISE
Bible Reference: Luke 24:45-53 and Acts 1:1-5	
Description: The disciples were filled with joy, and they returned to Jerusalem to wait for the promise. Waiting meant that every day they went to the Synagogue and they met in the upper room to pray.	
20	A BLESSING THEY DID NOT KNOW
Bible Reference: Acts 19:1-10	
Description: When Paul came to Ephesus, he asked believers there if they had been baptized in the Holy Spirit. They said they did not even know there was a Holy Spirit...	
21	THE CHRISTIANS AT ANTIOCH
Bible Reference: Acts 11:19-26	
Description: Believers went to a city called Antioch. There they started telling everyone about Jesus, and people were getting saved from their sin. The believers at Antioch were the first to be called Christians.	
22	SPEAKING IN TONGUES IS A SIGN FROM GOD
Bible Reference: Acts 8:14-24	
Description: Simon wanted what he saw on the others, and he offered to pay the Apostles to give it to him. Peter told him that the Baptism in the Holy Spirit is a gift from God.	
23	THE SPIRIT IS FOR ALL WHO SEEK
Bible Reference: Acts 15	
Description: They had all seen Gentiles saved and Baptized in the Holy Spirit. They knew this had really happened, because they had all heard Gentiles SPEAKING IN TONGUES.	
24	THE POSITIVE PROOF OF GOD IN US
Bible Reference: Acts 4:8-20	
Description: Paul and Barnabas explained to the people of Lystra that they were just human beings, and that what they were seeing was positive proof of the living God who created everything.	
25	CALLED TO THE GENTILES
Bible Reference: Acts 13:44-52	
Description: Paul and Barnabas began to speak in the streets or houses or anyplace where people would gather. Because of this many Gentiles began to hear about Jesus and were giving their hearts to Him and being saved.	
26	CHOSEN TO BLESS
Bible Reference: Genesis 12:1-3	
Description: God chose the people of Israel to bless the world. The people of Israel are to bless the world by living according to the commandments and promises of God.	
27	DAVID SPARES SAUL
Bible Reference: 2 Samuel 6:14-15 and 1 Samuel 26	
Description: David was able to have SELF-CONTROL and spare Saul by remembering always that God loved him and would take care of him no matter what.
