46	WITH JESUS COMES VICTORY
Bible Reference: Revelation 20:1-6	
Description: As He comes down from Heaven, Jesus will use a “great chain” to catch the devil, the false prophet and the devil’s beast and throw them into the “Abyss”.	
47	ISRAEL WILL BE RAISED-UP
Bible Reference: Zephaniah 3:19-20	
Description: Jesus has promised He will save the nation of Israel. He will heal them. He will gather them back to their promised land. He will make them such a great and mighty nation.	
48	WHEN GENTLENESS REIGNS
Bible Reference: Isaiah 11:6-9	
Description: During the MILLENNAIL REIGN of Jesus peace will be over the entire earth. There will be no more wars and all people will truly learn to love one another.	
49	THE ABYSS IS OPENED
Bible Reference: Revelation 20:7-8	
Description: At the end of the 1000 years, the abyss is going to be unlocked. The devil, the false prophet and the beast will all be released.	
50	A FOOLISH ATTACK
Bible Reference: Rev 20:9-10	
Description: The devil will then march with his army to Jerusalem, the city of God. God will send fire down from Heaven. The fire will burn-up all of the devil’s army.	
51	BEFORE THE THRONE
Bible Reference: Revelation 20:11-15	
Description: After the Millennial Reign of Jesus, everyone will come and stand before God’s Great White Throne for the Final Judgment.	
52	THE NEW HEAVENS AND NEW EARTH
Bible Reference: Revelation 21:1-9	
Description: In Revelation, John tells that there will be a new Heavens and a new Earth. This will happen, because the old will go away.	
53	THE NEW JERUSALEM
Bible Reference: Revelation 21:10-27	
Description: In the New Jerusalem there will not be a sun or moon, because God’s glory is going to light-up the whole place!	
54	THE RIVER LIFE
Bible Reference: Revelation 22:1-9	
Description: The River of Life will run right through New Jerusalem. We will be able to drink from it any time we like. Its water will be pure and sweet to the taste.
